DRAFT - How to submit a new Object/Resource to the "lwm2m-registry" via a 'Fork'

a. Once an Object/Resource has been submitted using the Editor tool an 'Issue' will be created in the lwm2m registry (https://github.com /OpenMobileAlliance/lwm2m-registry/issues) to start to the Object/Resource Approval process.

b. On the receipt of the 'Issue' the OMA staff will review the submitted Object/Resource.

- If your Object/Resource is accepted, then the 'Issue' will be updated with the instructions on how to submit a Pull Request.
- The 'Issue' instructions will include Object ID, Object URN, any errors in the object submission and details of the Object/Resource Submission Branch.
